Shortly after his birth in Point Cook, his mother died and he was nearly shot. After being poisoned by a corrupt stable-hand, Newminster went on to win the first Caulfield Cup in 1879. After his near death, Newminster's loosebox at the Point Cook Homestead drew immense crowds, becoming a tourist attraction.

In more recent times an estate and street in the Point Cook area were named after this renowned racehorse.
